

- a) rigorous proof that **Chomsky's** universal grammar does exist;
- b) an new revelation that the articulating tongue possesses a **matrix** that systematizes grammar;
- c) the solution to the definition of the **syllable**, which linguists have considered undefinable;
- d) the description of a so far unknown **wave**-like sequence of articulation underlying all of speech, that is a factor in determining word order, in the creation of vocabulary and of grammatical construction, in explaining historical changes in languages, etc.;
- e) the organic **taxonomy** of consonants that differs and is more useful than the current intuitive classification of consonants;
- f) the exact methodology that enables the **deaf** to correctly articulate.

To be completed:

- g) the lingual construct of grammatical genders;
- (h) the switching of respiratory phases and its grammatical role – a basic tool of physiology;
- i) the structuring of the basis of articulation of language and of the different languages, an approach so far not known because the key to its methodology has remained outside of current research. Altering the established methodology may require effort but it would offer a vast new area for study and important discoveries;
